

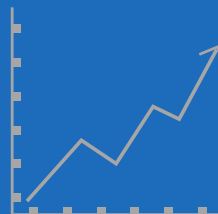
HOW WELL ARE OAKLAND SCHOOLS SERVING LOW-INCOME BLACK AND LATINO/A STUDENTS?

A guide to help parents and educators:

There are a few schools that are truly beating the odds and setting their low-income Black and Latino/a students up for a brighter future. But as a city, we are overall failing to provide these students with the opportunities they deserve. We need bold, radical changes to shift this reality.

Spotlight on Low-Income Black and Latino/a Students

There are 9,608 low-income Black students and 21,286 low-income Latino/a students enrolled in Oakland schools. While we know that all students - regardless of race or income - can achieve at high levels, we also know that opportunity is not distributed equally across our city. This guide presents school-level data that show what too many Oakland families know from personal experience: there are too few quality options for low-income Black and Latino/a students.

These lists show three key data points to help families understand their options and the current state of education in our city:

Percentage of Students Meeting Standards

Is this school setting its Black and Latino/a students on track for college?

While test scores don't capture everything families value in a school, it is the best indicator we have to know whether or not schools are putting students on track to college or the next step in their lives. A proficient score means that students are on grade-level in math or English.

Student Growth

Is this school helping its Black or Latino/a students grow academically from one year to the next?

Some students start the year very far behind grade-level. This data measures how much they advance in one year. Schools that are "high growth" are meeting their students where they are at and pushing them to make big progress over the course of the year.

High Suspensions

Does this school suspend its Black or Latino/a students at high rates?

We know that locally and nationally, students of color are suspended at higher rates. When students are removed from class, they are more likely to fall behind in academics and drop out of school. With each suspension, a student's chance of going to college decreases and their chance of going to prison increases.

Data sources and notes: Data is sourced from the California Department of Education: 2018-19 California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress Test Results and the 2018-19 California State Dashboard; and the OUSD CORE Growth Data Dashboard. This report includes both district and charter schools with more than 30 low-income Black or Latina/o test takers. The proficiency rates indicated only include those for the low-income Black or low-income Latina/o sub-group. The HIGH SUSPENSION FOR BLACK AND LATINA/O STUDENTS column is based on California School Dashboard. Schools with a red asterisk either received a red Dashboard rating for Black or Latina/o students on the suspension indicator or are in the "very high" status category for Black or Latina/o students on the suspension indicator. The GROWTH FOR BLACK AND LATINA/O STUDENTS column is based on the CORE Growth Index. High-growth schools have an index of 70 or above; low-growth schools have an index of 30 or below. N/A signifies that the school did either did not participate in CORE, did not have enough students to report data, or opted not to publicly report CORE data. The growth measure includes all Black and Latina/o students, not only low-income Black and Latina/o students.
